1. The following may not be included in any publication (other than the Claimant's name only): (a) the name, address or school of any of the Claimant's wife and/or children (the names of whom are set out in the Schedule attached hereto); (b) any particulars or other personal information which might lead to identification of the Claimant's wife and/or children (other than the Claimant's name); (c) any picture, photograph or other image that is or includes any picture or image of any of the Claimant, the Claimant's wife and/or children; (d) the name of the nursing home, hospice or other health care facility in which the Claimant resides.
2. Costs reserved.
3. The Claimant to serve this Order, the Claim Form and all other papers upon the Defendant forthwith.
4. Liberty to apply.
5. The Claimant (by his representatives) to attend before the Court at the hearing for determination of permission in the case of *R (Conway) v Ministry of Justice* CO/6421/2016 on 21 March 2017 to seek directions for case management.

Reasons:

1. The Claimant's application for urgent immediate relief, so far as identification of his wife, children and any personal details other than his own name are concerned, is justified.
