Following consideration of the Application Notice lodged by Bindmans LLP on 22 September 2016, and consideration of the documents lodged in response to the Application Notice by the defendant and Bindmans LLP

IT IS ORDERED:

 At the end of paragraph 13 of the court's order of 26 July 2016 the following words are added:

"For the avoidance of doubt, the parties are not prohibited from publishing (1) the Defendant's or their own Detailed Grounds (2) their own skeleton arguments. If redactions are necessary to protect parties' identities or addresses, these documents must be published in a redacted form."

 Three sets of joint trial bundles shall be agreed between the parties and shall be lodged with the Administrative Court Office by 4pm on 3rd October 2016

REASONS

As to 1: Against the background of the principle of open justice, it is difficult to see a justification for restricting publication of documents which are generally available under the Rules. Redactions can address the concern with abuse of individual parties in the case. Further applications on this matter can be directed to the Court hearing the case.

As to 2: There was no provision for trial bundles in the original order
